Bulls 27, Bonnies 8

Bulls out-run Bonnies

The Bulls used their speed and size to run away from the Bonnies, 27-8. The Bulls started hot right off the bat, outscoring their opponent 13-4 in the 1st half. The Bulls were led by the two-headed attack of Ava Devald (8 points, 7 rebounds, 2 steals) and Sophia Waliszewski (12 points, 8 rebounds, 9 steals, 1 block). Ava had 6 points in the first quarter alone, and then Sophia used her speed and agility to get to the basket in the 2nd half, scoring 4 points, by crossing-over defenders left and right. Natalie Prezioso (5 points, 1 rebound) also had a solid game, using her speed to sneak past defenders, and make multiple lay-ups on the night.

Despite the final score, the Bonnies played very hard all evening, as they were led by Grace (2 points, 4 rebounds, 1 steal) and Gabby Giesing (4 steals, 12 rebounds, 1 assist, 12 steals). Gabby Giesing was the motor of the Bonnies, scoring a basket in the first half, while ripping down 8 rebounds and registering 6 steals. Emma Schwabe also had a solid game, scoring 2 points and snagging 11 rebounds for the Bonnies.

The Bulls, however, continued to dominate in the 2nd half. Waliszewski added another 8 points and got over 7 steals in the half alone. She applied an intense amount of pressure to the Bonnies point guards, helping the Bulls run away with it. In the 4th quarter, Maggie Shiesley added a jumper along with ripping down 3 rebounds.

During the loss, Lexi Gampp did a good job of breaking the Bulls pressure, and getting the ball into the paint.

The Bulls won, 27-8.
