Mystics outpace Liberty

The Mystics got everyone involved on Saturday, as 7 players found the score sheet. In the first quarter, Kyler Shiesley (10 points, 1 rebound), Maddie Ringler (16 points, 5 rebounds, 1 assist), and Hailey Bronson (4 points, 1 rebound) all hit jumpers for the Mystics. At the end of the 1st, the Mystics held a 7-0 lead.

The Mystics blew the game open in the 2nd quarter. Each player played unselfishly, finding the open teammate for the best possible shot. Sophia Waliszewski (8 points, 1 assist, 2 steals) was making moves in the 2nd quarter, scoring 4 points on nice drives to basket, while also finding Natalie Endres (2 points, 2 rebounds, 2 steals, 3 blocks) for a jumper.
