Oregon 39, Duke 19

Oregon defeats Duke

Oregon got off to a quick start and never looked back in their victory over Duke. Domenic Hickok (27 points, 25 rebounds, 3 steals, 6 blocks) led the way, scoring 13 points in the first quarter alone. He was very efficient, as he would take steals or rebounds, and use his speed to dash to the basket for easy lay-ups. Connor Burkestone was also very efficient (8 points, 9 rebounds), complementing Hickok's play to add a nice 1-2 punch. Evan Johnson (4 points, 11 rebounds, 1 steal) also added a basket in the first. At the end of the 1st, Oregon led 17-2.

Hickok added another 4 points, in the 2nd quarter, while Evan Johnson ripped down 5 boards. Joseph Holman (4 points, 5 rebounds) added a basket for Duke in the frame, and Ian Wilson (5 rebounds) ripped down 3 boards.

Connor Burkstone added 6 points in the 3rd quarter, including a 3-pointer. Domenic Hickok grabbed 4 rebounds in the quarter for Duke, and Evan Johnson hit another lay-up. For Duke, Jack Porter (7 points, 3 rebounds) dropped 5 points, including a 3-pointer that hit nothing but net. Aidan Hurely (4 points, 2 rebounds) also grabbed a rebound and basket, while Joseph Homan made a basket off a nice pass from Luke Bradley. However, at the end of the 3rd, Oregon held a 29-13 lead.

Domenic Hickok put the game away in the 4th, scoring an additional 10 points while snagging 6 rebounds. Evan Johnson and Connor Burkestone each grabbed 4 rebounds a-piece.

For Duke, Jack Porter and Thomas Polek (2 points, 6 rebounds) worked together to score a few baskets, while Brody Lyons also hit a jumper from the corner. In the loss, Michael Logar grabbed 4 rebounds.

Oregon defeated Duke, 39-19.
