Blue Devils 27, Bengals 7

Gabby Schmidt leads Blue Devils past Bengals

Gabby Schmidt had a game to remember on Monday night, scoring 19 points, grabbing 5 rebounds, having an assist, and snagging 8 steals. In the first quarter, after 4 minutes of scoreless ball, Gabby Schmidt went on to score 8 of her teams 10 points in the frame. She got to the basket with ease in the first quarter, while also recording 3 steals. Maddie Caron (2 points, 7 rebounds, 7 steals) also added a basket and 5 rebounds in the frame. At the end of the first quarter, the Blue Devils led 10-2.

Haley Geartz (2 points, 9 rebounds) got in on the action in the 2nd quarter for the Blue Devils, as she scored a basket and grabbed 3 rebounds. For the Bengals, Ellie Fox grabbed 3 rebounds, and Emma Bush added 2 rebounds. At the end of the first half, the Blue Devils led 12-2.

In the 3rd quarter, Gabby Schmidt added another basket and assisted on a basket by Maddie O'Sullivan, who nailed the 10-foot jumper. Maddie Carron snagged 4 steals in the quarter to help push the pace of play. The Bengals also began to find some offensive momentum, as Emma Bush (2 points, 5 rebounds) made a jumper. Avery Devonshire (3 points, 2 rebounds, 3 steals) also scored on a free-throw, as she did a nice job of getting to the basket. At the end of the 3rd quarter, the Blue Devils led 16-5.

Gabby Schmidt looked like a girl on a mission in the 4th quarter, as she scored 9 points in the frame. She did a great job of pressuring the ball, and then going coast-to-coast for lay-ups. She also hit two 15-foot jumpers in the frame. Haley Geartz also added a 3 rebounds and a basket in the quarter, while Victoria Kowalewski added 3 rebounds for a total of 7 on the evening. For the Bengals, Avery Devonshire added another basket, nailing the shot from the quarter. Aslyn Gabel added 2 rebounds in the quarter.

The Blue Devils defeated the Bengals 27-7.
