Warriors 28, 76ers 15

Warriors defeat 76ers

The Warriors got off to a fast start, which ultimately led them to victory on Saturday. The Warriors outscored the 76ers 8-0 in the 1st quarter. Colton Becker (6 points) and AJ Cinquino (7 points, 4 rebounds, 4 steals, 4 blocks) paved the way for the Warriors early. Becker scored 4 points in the 1st quarter, using great hesitation moves and floaters to the basket. Cinquino added 3 points in the 1st quarter.

The Warriors continued to dominate in the first 4 minutes of the 2nd quarter, as Becker and Cinquino added another basket. Richie Andres (2 points, 2 assists) also added a basket. However, the 76ers began to find their footing later in the quarter. Connor Shiesley (6 points, 1 rebound, 3 steals) got the scoring rolling, and then Brayden Wilson (6 points) hit a bucket. He worked well with Brody Schmutzler, who added a buzzer-beating basket at the very end of the 2nd quarter. The Warriors held a 13-6 lead at half time.

The Warriors opened up the 2nd half with a beautiful pass from Richie Andres to Diego Andres (4 points), who hooked up for a 2 point basket. A few minutes later, they had a little déjà vu, running the same play once again. Cinquino also added a basket and Ryan Richner hit a big basket as well. The 76ers continued to battle in the 3rd however. Brayden Wilson added 4 points, and Matthew Vittum had an offensive rebound and basket. Connor Shiesley also hit a nice floater in the lane. The Warriors still held a 23-14 lead, however.

In the 4th quarter, the star of the show was Corin Harden, who added a free-throw and spin-a-rama basket to put the 76ers away. After the basket, Corin gave the ultimate celebration raising both arms up in the air in triumph. The Warriors defeated the 76ers, 28-15.
