- 4) **Easter Egg Hunt and Sensory Egg Hunt:** We had 515 kids sign up for the Easter Egg Hunt and another 66 for the Sensor Egg Hunt. It was a great turn out. Group was separated into two sessions which was great to decrease the chaos. We had a toddler area fenced off specific for kids 5 and under and 50 golden eggs per session. We had Llama visitation area, meet and greet with Easter Bunny.

Post Prom: We reviewed survey results from the kids regarding what they would potentially like to see for a post prom event. Bon-fire, cookout food (Hamburgers, Hot Dogs), live music. Due to the proximity of homes and lateness of the event we wouldn’t be able to do the event at Pinewoods Park. Other parks (Gratwick came to mind) would be good; however there is really no indoor option in case of inclement weather-plus Gratwick gets very windy). Michelle reached

out to Bob Brennan and discussed the potential to hold the event at Gratwick Fire Hall. It's available and they are donating the space! We also discussed and decided to have casino themed games inside with music (either live or DJ depending on what we can get), and include an ice cream bar. Bonfire will be outside with outside themed entertainment, and use of the pavilion area outside.
