ANKLE BREAKERS COOL OFF HOT SHOTS WITH BLOWOUT WIN IN REGULAR SEASON FINALE

Thanks to a 22-point outing in the second quarter, head coach Jordan Fox and the ANKLE BREAKERS blew past the HOT SHOTS, 52-31. Alex Fletcher led the way with another double-double on the season with 36 points and 21 rebounds along with 5 assists and teammate Jacob Schiesser finished with 10 points (8 points in the third quarter) and 13 rebounds. Quinn Haynes led a valiant effort for the HOT SHOTS, coached by Lou Medina, finishing with 17 points.

In the first quarter, the ANKLE BREAKERS had a 12-8 lead. Fletcher scored 10 points while Nick Woroniecki had a put-back basket. For the HOT SHOTS, Haynes, Aidan Ferry, Drew Barnes and Val Moscato had a basket apiece.

In the second quarter, the floodgates were opened as Fletcher scored a game-best 18 points in the frame to build a 34-12 lead for the ANKLE BREAKERS. Schiesser and Woroniecki scored a basket apiece as well while Haynes converted a three-pointer and a free-throw for the HOT SHOTS.

In the third quarter, the ANKLE BREAKERS built a 30-point lead thanks to 8 points from Schiesser and 6 points from Fletcher plus a basket from Alex Antonacci. The HOT SHOTS countered with 5 points from Haynes and a three-pointer from Alexis Juliano.

The HOT SHOTS outscored the ANKLE BREAKERS 11-2 in the fourth quarter thanks to 6 points from Haynes, a pair of lay-ups from Nick Syposs and a free-throw from Barnes.

In the victory, Woroniecki and Antonacci added 4 rebounds apiece.

In the loss, Ferry added a team-high 10 rebounds to go along with his basket while Braeson Reese-Scott added 8 rebounds.
