Bonnies quiet Griffs

The Bonnies used a combination of stellar defense and sound offense to beat the Golden Griffs 16-7 on Monday night.

The Griffs locked in from the get-go and played rough and tough defense, holding the Bonnies to only a pair of baskets in the opening quarter, coming from Kaylee Juliano (4 points, 11 rebounds, 3 steals, 2 blocks) and Lexi Gampp (2 points, 1 rebound, 1 assist). Anila Sopi drained an interior basket following a rebound to make it a 4-2 ball game.

The Bonnies began to pull away scoring eight consecutive points, as Gabby Giesing (4 points, 4 rebounds, 8 steals) and Grace Giesing (6 points, 8 rebounds) worked hard to score against the Griffs defense. The Golden Griffs came to life in the final quarter as Kaitlin Johnston heated up with a pair of beautiful jump shots; however the Bonnies were able to hold on for the 16-7 victory.

In the win, Ella Smith quietly played a great game, contributing on both ends of the floor with 5 rebounds and a pair of steals on the defensive end; while showing great moves to the basket on the offensive end. Emma Schwabe added 7 rebounds, 3 steals and 2 blocks while Amber Gambino ripped down 4 rebounds in the winning effort.

For the Golden Griffs, Emma Stahl played great defense and flew all over the floor using her speed to collect 2 steals and grab 5 loose balls. Anila Sopi finished with 3 points, 7 rebounds and a block while Elena Sclafani added 10 rebounds, 2 blocks and a steal. Nora Davidson played lock down defense, not allowing her opponent to score, as did Isabella Langworthy (4 rebounds) and Sage Pohl (5 rebounds).
