Late surge sinks Bengals

The Bengals played tough, and held a brief lead late in the third quarter; however a late surge from the Blue Devils in the form of baskets from Maddie Caron and Haley Geartz in the final quarter helped the Devils pull away with a 12-8 victory.

The Bengals held an early lead getting baskets from Adalyn Devonshire (2 points, 2 rebounds, 1 steal) and Ellie Fox (6 points, 5 rebounds, 1 steal 3 blocks). Emily Desiderio (2 points, 2 rebounds, 1 steal) scored a basket for the Blue Devils to cut the deficit to 4-2 by halftime.

In the third quarter both teams traded baskets as Maddie Maddie Caron (4 points, 6 rebounds, 1 assist, 6 steals) scored for the Blue Devils and the Bengals answered with consecutive baskets from Ellie Fox to give the Bengals the 8-6 lead prior to Gabby Schmidt (4 points, 5 rebounds, 2 steals, 1 block) hitting a contested turn-around jumper (her second basket of the quarter) to tie the game at 8-8 heading into the final quarter.

In the final frame, Haley Geartz and Maddie Caron each drained baskets to seal the close victory for the Blue Devils. In the loss, Grace and Ashlyn Gabel played tremendous defense, combining for 8 steals, while Madison Mascardo added a nice assist on the offensive end. In the winning effort, Victoria Kowalewski played great defense and added 3 rebounds.
