Blue Devils sink Cardinals

It was a fast-paced game that featured lots of steals and transition baskets, and ultimately the Blue Devils scored a pair of late baskets to break open the game in the 20-16 victory.

Hailey Geartz (8 points, 5 rebounds, 1 steal) led the way for the Blue Devils scoring eight points; however it was Emily Desiderio (4 points, 5 rebounds, 1 assist, 4 steals) that gave the Devils a boost with her great defense and great teamwork.

The Cardinals were led by Lilly Day (8 points, 6 rebounds, 3 steals) who did a great job on both ends of the floor; however baskets by Maddie Caron (4 points, 6 rebounds, 1 assist, 3 steals) and Lilian Specht gave the Devils the 14-10 lead at halftime.

In the second half the Cardinals got baskets by Lila Mirowski who hit a long jumper and Lila Giannantonio who secured a rebound and drained the jumper to tie the game. The Cardinals continued to sink in on defense as Peyton Smith added 3 steals, while Ella Winkler added 4 steals.

In the final quarter the Blue Devils broke open the game as Gabby Schmidt (2 points, 1 rebound, 1 assist, 5 steals) took over on the defensive end, grabbing a handful of steals, turning one of them into a fast-break layup. Later in the game, she spun around, evading a double-team and dished out an assist as Haley Geartz hit the jumper.
