2021 Statement of Commitment

The North Tonawanda Youth Board is to initiate continuous preventive and remedial planning and the coordination of Youth Services in the City of North Tonawanda. As a member of the North Tonawanda Youth Board I commit myself to:

1. Work with the Youth Programming Supervisor in developing effective policies and programs that further youth development and prevents and controls delinquency.
2. Review the executive, administrative, and legislative regulations with respect to the solutions of youth problems and/or the enactment of youth programs, and make recommendations as needed.
3. Encourage closer cooperation between employers, schools, churches, recreation commissions, state and local employments, service clubs other public and private agencies so as to stimulate youth employment programs on the basis of community planning.
4. Be aware of and apply for grants that are available from the state, federal, or county governments or from private individuals, corporations, or associations and establish criteria for allocation of these funds to youth programs.
5. Assist the Youth Programming Supervisor, review and evaluate, accept/reject plans for the creation/expansion of recreation and youth service projects or other youth programs as defined by the laws of the State of New York and make appropriate recommendations to the Mayor and the Common Council of the City of North Tonawanda.
6. Assess the needs of the youth residing in North Tonawanda by gathering, reviewing, and analyzing statistical records and data that reflect the incidence and trends of delinquency and youthful crimes and offenses in the City of North Tonawanda.
7. Seek out advice from groups and individuals that possess expertise that may be helpful to the North Tonawanda Youth Board in carrying out its powers and responsibilities.
8. North Tonawanda Youth Board members are expected to attend 75% of the scheduled monthly meetings each calendar year. Meetings for 2021 will be held on the following dates:
